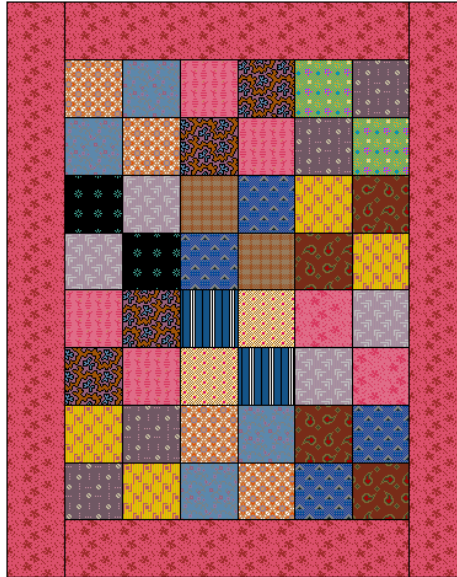


Simple Little Doll Quilt



Materials for 13 1/2" X 16 1/2 " quilt:

- 1/4 yard medium blue fabric
- 1/4 yard total of assorted fabric scraps
- 1/4 yard red fabric for borders
- 15" X 18" piece of fabric for backing
- 15" X 18" piece of cotton batting
- 1/4 yard blue binding fabric

Cut 24 2" squares from medium blue fabric. Cut 24 2" squares from assorted fabric scraps. Cut 2 1/2 " strips from red fabric. With right sides together and using a 1/4-inch seam, sew one blue square to a scrap square. Press. Piece two pairs of squares into a block, flipping the blue squares opposite each other. Make 12 blocks.

Sew three blocks together into a row. Make 4 rows. Press. Sew each row of three to the next row until you have sewn all four rows together. Press. Measure top and bottom of quilt and cut the red border strips to fit. Sew border to top and bottom of quilt. Measure sides of quilt and cut the remaining border strip to fit the sides. Sew. Layer quilt top with batting (middle) and backing. Quilt an X in the center of each block with a simple quilting stitch. Cut 1 1/2" strips from blue binding fabric and attach binding using your favorite binding method.
