

❖ Friendship Garden Mystery Quilt 2018 - Step 3 ❖

Read through the directions before you begin.

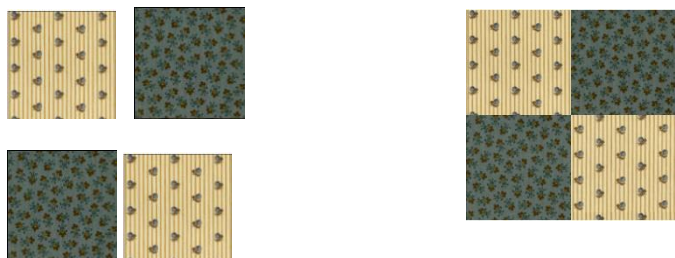
1. First, find the center applique section you made in Step 1 (applique or star) and the four flying geese units you made in Step 2.
2. Then, cut four light print squares that measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$.
3. Next, make 8 four-patch blocks:

Cut 16 squares (2" x 2") from a medium or dark print fabric. **Make sure these are a different color than the flying geese you made in Step 2.**

Cut 16 squares (2" x 2") from a light print.

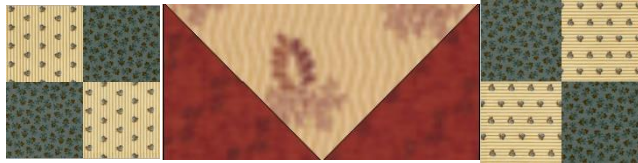
Note: These should all be from the same 2 prints.

Sew a light 2" square to a medium print 2" square. Make 16 units. Sew the units together as shown to make a four-patch block. Make 8 matching blocks. Trim to $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ (They will measure 3" when FINISHED in the quilt).



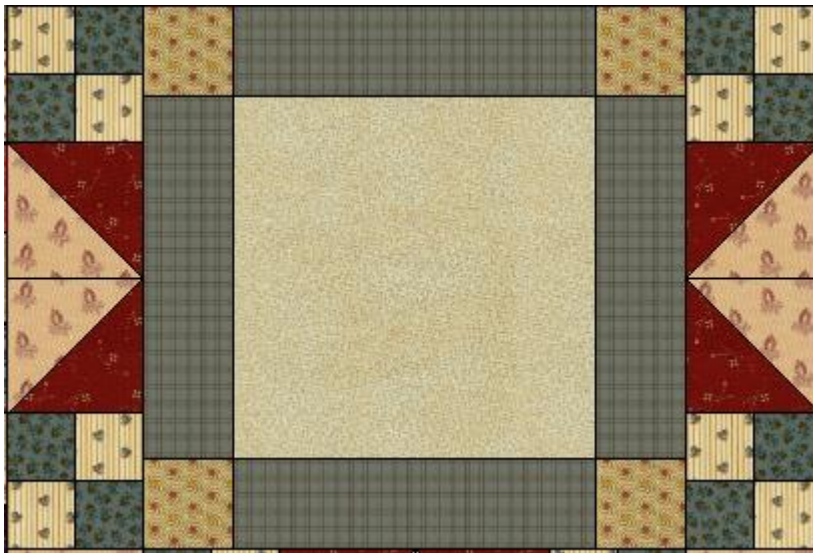
Make 8 matching four-patch blocks.

4. Sew the flying geese units together with the four patches as shown to make four strips.



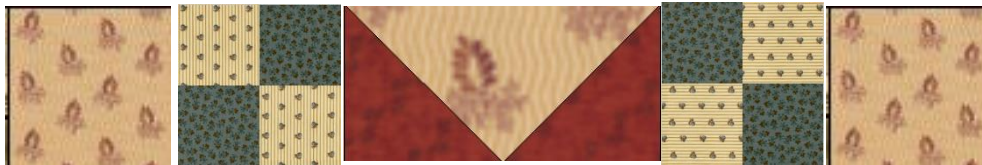
Make 4.

5. Sew two of the strips to the sides of your center section.



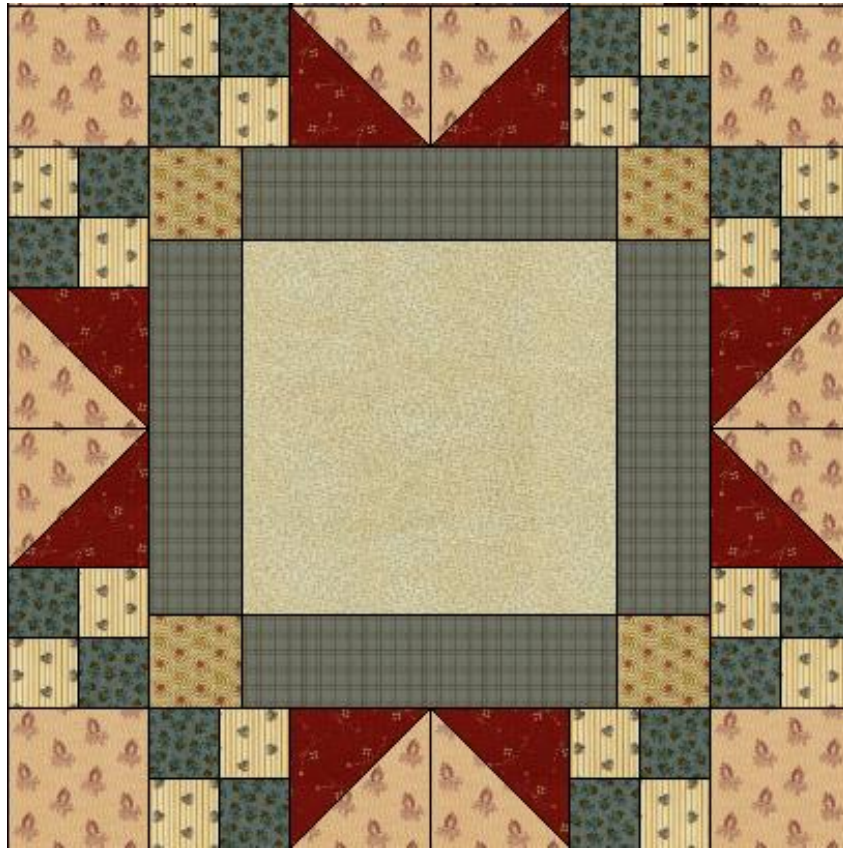
(ignore lines in flying geese)

6. Sew the 3 1/2" light squares to both ends of the remaining two strips.



Make 2.

7. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of your quilt.
