

Autumn Leaves Sew Along - Week 4

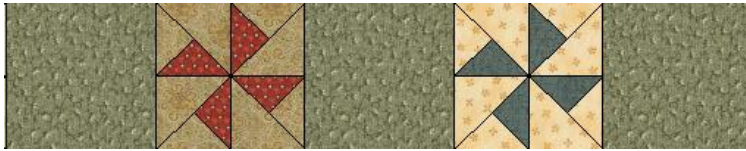

This week we'll sew our Turnstile blocks together with plain squares - light or dark, your choice - to sew a border on the quilt.

Cut: 12 squares that measure $3 \frac{5}{8}$ " x $3 \frac{5}{8}$ ". (This is just a smidgen more than $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ".) You'll need $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of fabric for these squares if you use the same print. Or just use some of your scraps and choose different prints for each square like I did. Play around with some colors and prints and see what makes your quilt shine and puts a smile on your face. See some suggestions at the end of this file.

Directions

1. Sew two Turnstile blocks together with three $3 \frac{5}{8}$ " plain squares exactly as shown. Make 2 strips.

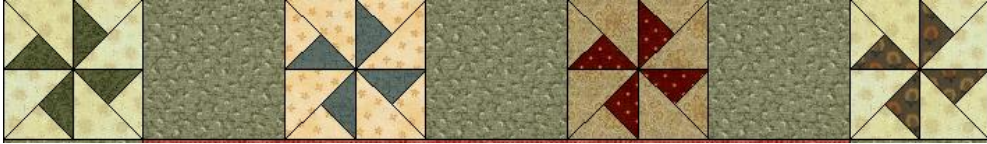


Make 2 strips.

2. Sew these strips to the sides of your quilt. Press toward the border.



3. Sew four Turnstile blocks together with three plain squares exactly as shown. Make 2 strips.



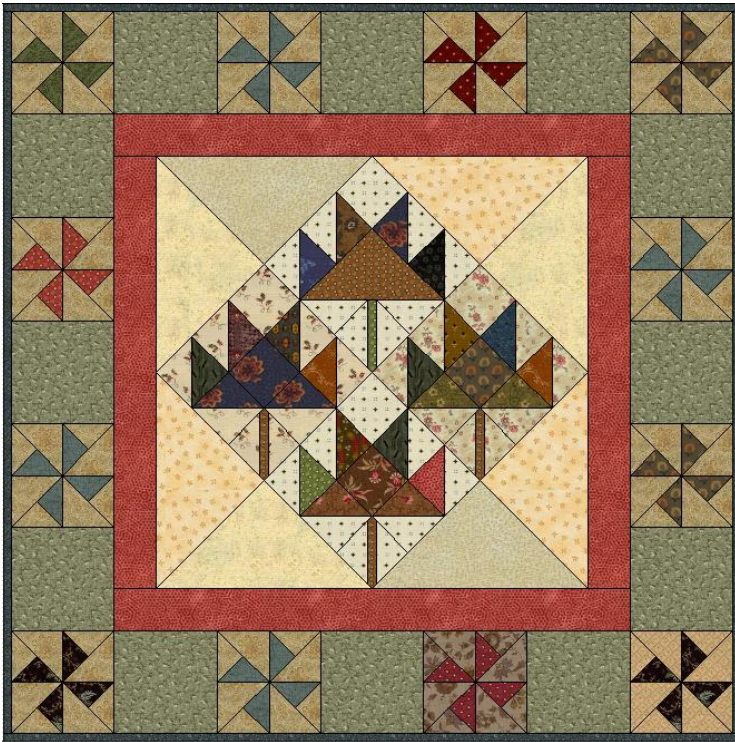
Make 2 strips.

4. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of your quilt.



5. Layer the top with batting and backing cut slightly larger than the top. Quilt as you wish. Add a 1 1/4" single-fold binding to finish.
