
& Civil War Mini Quilt Sew Along, 2025 &

3" x 3" Finished

Materials

Assorted reproduction fabric scraps

Cutting

From a medium or light print, cut:

2 squares, 17/8" x 17/8"

4 rectangles, 1" x 1 ½"

1 square, 1 ½" x 1 ½"

From a medium or dark print, cut

2 squares, 17/8" x 17/8"

4 rectangles, 1" x 1 ½"

Directions

1. Make 4 half-square triangles from the light and the medium or dark 1 7/8" squares: Layer a light print square together with a medium or dark print square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from coner to corner across the lighter square. Stitch 1/4" away from the line on either side. Cut on the drawn lline. Flip open and press. Make 4 half square triangles in the same color.






2. Sew a light 1" x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together with a medium or dark rectangle. Unit should measure 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4.

3. Sew the half-square triangles together with the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle pairs as shown. Sew the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " light print square together with two rectangle pairs for the center row. Sew the 3 rows together. Your block should measure 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4 blocks.
