

# ★ *Fourth of July Mini Mystery Quilt – Step 1* ★

Grab some scraps of red, light and blue fabrics and join me in making a simple (but sweet) little patriotic quilt. This quilt will finish at less than 12" x 12" depending upon how you cut your borders (Step 2). So easy it will be finished in a jiffy and ready to display for the July 4 holiday.

Cut four red squares, **1 ¼" x 1 ¼"**

Cut 5 light print squares, **1 ¼" x 1 ¼"**

Cut 2 light print squares, **3 ½" x 3 ½"** (same print or different for scrappy)

Cut 2 blue squares, **3 ½" x 3 ½"**

Cut 4 light print squares, **2 ¾" x 2 ¾"** (same print or different)



Some of these squares are very small pieces, so remember to cut and sew accurately. (I always sew with a scant ¼" seam, slightly less than ¼".) Step 2 will be uploaded to the files in a few days.
