

Aunt Addie's Blue Ribbon Quilt

Kathleen Tracy's 2019 Mystery Quilt - Block # 6

Finished block size: 4" x 4"



YOU WILL MAKE SIX BLOCKS

Materials

Scraps of light or medium prints

Scraps of medium or dark prints

(You may switch the lights and darks within the blocks.)

Cutting

From a light print scrap, cut

4 matching squares, 1 ½" x 1 ½"

2 squares, 1 7/8" x 1 7/8". Cut once on diagonal to make 4 triangles

From the medium or dark print scraps, cut

4 rectangles, 1 ½" x 2 ½"

1 square, 1 7/8" x 1 7/8"

Make the Block

1. For each block, sew 2 light print $1\frac{7}{8}$ " triangles to opposite sides of a medium or dark print $1\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Press and sew the remaining triangles to the top and bottom of the square.



2. Sew matching $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to the ends of two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

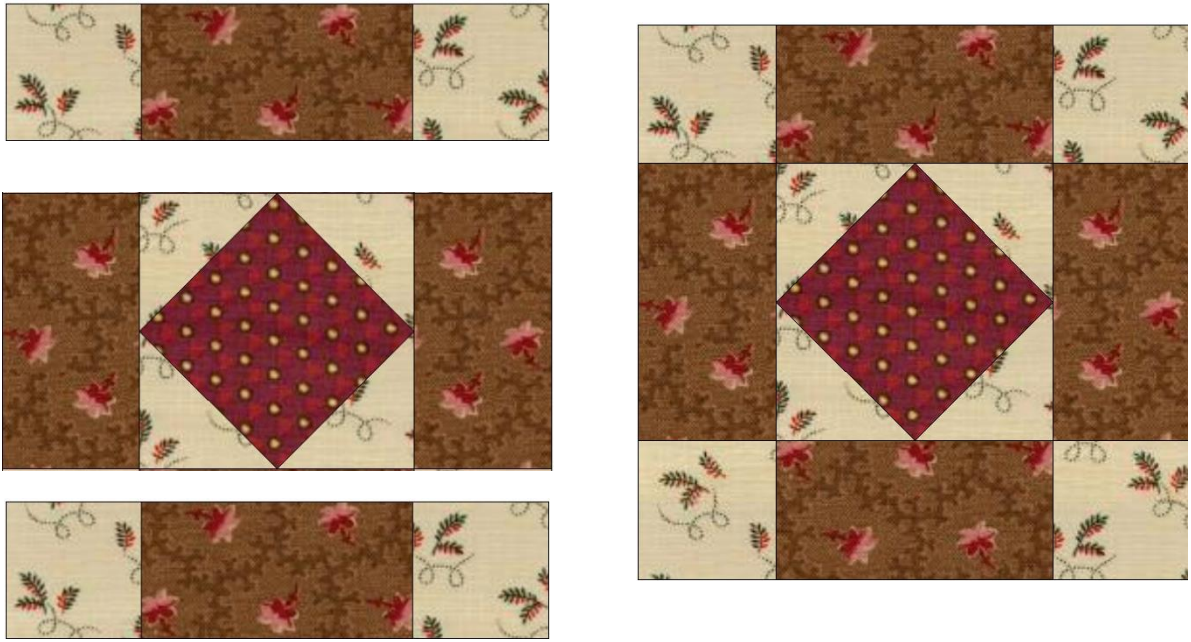


Make 2.

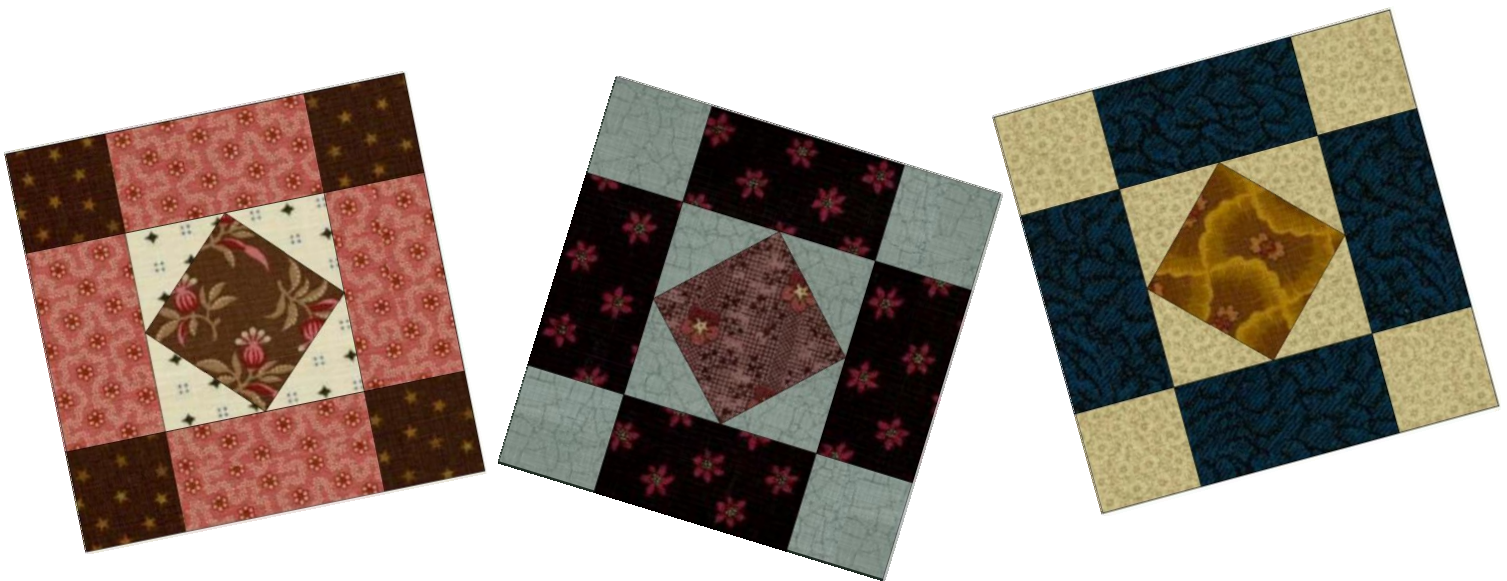
3. Sew two matching medium or dark print rectangles to both sides of the square in square unit from step 1.



4. Put the block together as shown. Press and trim to 4 1/2" x 4 1/2". **Make 6 blocks.**

Next month, I'll give you the finishing directions and you can begin to put your blocks together into a quilt. You will need some extra fabric for the setting and borders (not to mention backing and binding).
