

# *Schoolgirl Sampler Sew Along*

## Week 11

Work on Blocks **61 through 66** on pages 70 - 72 of the Schoolgirl Sampler book.

You should not have much difficulty with the blocks for this week. Block 63 uses Stich and Flip corners so see page 9 for those instructions. Place a B square (1 ½") on one corner of a 2 ½" square, sew a line on the diagonal, stitch and flip open. For Block 64, make the C/E half-square triangles first, sew the F triangles (1 7/8") next exactly as shown on page 71 and add the larger A/B triangles last.

You've all been doing so great and I hope that, in addition to picking up some new skills, you're also having fun. If you think about it, you've all really come far in three months. Making so many of these 4" blocks is a really big deal! I know it might not have been easy for some of you who are beginners or just not used to working with such small pieces or for who have lots of other commitments. Don't worry too much if your blocks are not quite perfect. Do the best you can. None of the imperfections will show after the blocks are sewn together and the quilt is quilted. Each one of you will have a lovely quilt to call your own in the end.

I'll include a plan for putting the rest of the quilt together in the file for Week 12. The LAST six blocks will be posted on **Friday, March 19.**
