Week 7

Work on Blocks **37 through 42** on pages 58 - 60 of the Schoolgirl Sampler book.

No tough blocks this week. Read below if you have trouble with the flying geese blocks. Mastering these blocks will definitely help you with precision sewing. If you do have a problem getting them to come out to the correct size, you can always use a 1 ½" x 2 ½" Bloc Loc or other small Flying Geese ruler for trimming. But, I do think if you take your time and sew carefully and you may not need any help. Review the tips for Week 6 on making Flying Geese and suggestions for Flying Geese rulers.

I would not be surprised if some of you have become better piecers as you go through this process of making the 72 small blocks. Remember that sewing seams with a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " may help some of you with piecing.

Keep sewing half-square triangles for your border. The next six blocks will be posted on **Friday, February 19.**
